## Welcome to Camp Spicewood

## Here are some camp survival tips:

- 1. Records & Tuition We must have all paperwork (registration form-top half, enrollment information, waiver of liability and immunization chart) completed and on file. \$100 registration fee is due at time of registration. Tuition is due on the first day of each session, we accept checks and cash only.
- **2.** <u>Labels</u> Please label all your child's belongings and do not send toys, video games, cell phones etc. Your child needs only a bag or a backpack, swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, lunch, and a water bottle.
- **3.** Sunblock Please apply before arriving. Please provide sunscreen (spray is preferred, thank you). We will remind and help your child reapply sunscreen throughout the day.
- **Lunch & Drinks** Please pack a lunch and water bottle for your child. Sorry that we cannot provide refrigeration; cold packs work great. We will sell carbonated drinks, juice drinks, and sports drinks for \$1.00 during lunch. Please send correct change each day or send a drink. We have cold water available at all times.
- **5. Snacks** One free snack will be provided each day. Your child will have a variety of several choices; including ice cream, frozen treats, goldfish, fruit snacks, chips, slushies, etc.......
- **Yell Practice** At 9:05 each morning, campers and counselors will gather at their designated group tables located around playground (socially distanced from other groups) for announcements and a few cheers. Each group will be dismissed one at a time to begin their daily activities.
- 7. <u>Drop -Off & Pick- Up</u> Signs will be placed to direct parking for drop-off and pick-up. Parents or caregivers please park and remain in your car at drop-off and pick-up for the safety of all children, parents, and staff.

**Camper Drop-Off:** Camp staff will meet you at your car to perform camper's daily temperature check and Covid- 19 health questions (if camper's temperature exceeds 100. F, is indicating illness, or parent answers yes to any Covid -19 health questions, the camper will be asked to remain home). Campers will be escorted into camp by camp staff. Please have enrollment form, consent and liability form, the latest copy of immunization record, and tuition payment (Spicewood accepts checks and cash only) ready on the first day check-in, thank you.

Camper Pick-Up: Campers will be escorted to their cars by camp staff. Parents or caregivers, please park and remain in your car at pick-up for the safety of all children, parents, and staff.
